

2019 Peeps Diorama Contest RULES

Diorama display can have any theme, as long as it is “family-friendly” (suitable for all audiences). Examples include: books, movies, television shows, musicals, historical scenes, science fiction, you name it!

- Diorama parts should all fit inside a box the size of a shoe box. (Maximum size: 12” x 18” x 12”) You may remove one or more sides of the box if you wish.
- All visible parts of the diorama should be decorated, including the outside of the box.
- All characters in your scene should be made using Peeps®.
- Limit one entry per person or team. For teams, choose the category of your oldest team member.
- Dioramas are to be submitted either on **Saturday, March 30, 9 AM - 4:30 PM** or on **Sunday, March 31, 1- 4:30 PM**. Drop them off at either the Children’s or Adult Information Desks.
- The winners will be announced at our **Peeps Party: Monday, April 1, 7 –7:30 PM**. All participants and the public are invited to attend, where they will be able to see all of the entries on display and vote for the People’s Choice Award!
- The winning dioramas in each of the categories will be on display in the Children’s Room from April 2 - 7, and **must be picked up by April 14 at 5 PM**; otherwise they will be discarded. All other entries are to be taken home immediately following the party.

- Each entry will be judged on **Originality, Overall Appearance**, and **Creative Use of Peeps**. Prizes include toy Peeps®, Peeps® books, and Target gift cards, courtesy of the Friends of the Library.

We will do our best to keep your diorama safe, but the library is not responsible for any damage to your diorama. By entering the diorama contest, you are giving the Stow-Munroe Falls Public Library permission to display your diorama in the library, take pictures of your creation and share them online.
