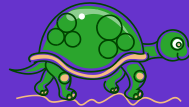

Finding your way:

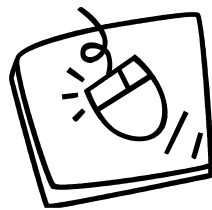


We would like to encourage all of our patrons to visit our bright and spacious children's area. You will find a variety of materials shelved by age level and type including:

Using Technology

There are many ways for young children to experience technology in the Children's Room. There are twelve computers, which offer internet access and children's games. Toddlers can get the feel of using a mouse,



while older students can brush up on their problem solving skills, all while enjoying fun and interesting games. For novice users, our website will show the way with fun and interesting

Early and struggling readers can enjoy a book that talks back, with Tumblebooks, our online picture books database. Children's groups like the boy scouts and girl scouts can schedule computer training in our computer lab. School age children can register for computer classes taught at several skill levels. Also, ask us about our children's iPad classes and programs.
