I am visiting the Stow-Munroe Falls Public Library.






If I need to, I can park in the accessible parking spots in front of the library and use the button to enter the library through the front door.

The library can be a noisy and busy place. I can ask for a quiet area or a Sensory Kit.










When I walk around the first floor, this is what I'll see.






If I need help finding an item, reserving a room, or with a computer, I can ask for help at the Information Desk.




These are the restrooms on the first floor.



There is also a family restroom upstairs.






The Children's Department is upstairs on the second floor. I can use the stairs or elevator to get there.



There are also meeting rooms upstairs. I can attend a program there or schedule a meeting in the rooms.




When I'm ready to check out my items, I go to the Checkout Area at the front of the library.
